How does KYND work?

KYND scans a single URL to uncover exposed services, critical vulnerabilities, and connected assets. The non-invasive scan checks more than 280 cyber risk factors, including domain registration, email security, and internet-facing services.

What is KYND ON?

KYND ON is a cyber risk monitoring platform that helps you quickly understand and prevent threats. It gives instant visibility into your organization's internal and external cyber posture, with continuous monitoring to reduce exposure and stay ahead of risks.

What is a Risk Report?

The Risk Report — which can be generated in the KYND ON platform — is a one-off report that reveals where your business may be vulnerable to cyber threats.

This powerful, non-intrusive scan identifies external risks and vulnerabilities that could expose you to attacks. With clear and actionable recommendations, it provides a concise snapshot of your organization's cyber risk at a specific moment in time.



What's in a Risk Report?

Your KYND ON Risk Report will show a clear, traffic light-style view of your cyber risk — so you know exactly where you stand at a glance. The dial numbers represent the risk factors that KYND has discovered.

- **RED:** Marked as “High risks”, these are the risks that KYND believes will cause business interruption if not addressed.
- **AMBER:** Marked as “For consideration”, these are the risks that KYND believes may cause possible business interruption if not addressed.
- **GREEN:** Marked as “Look Good”, these risks appear not to carry an immediate risk based upon the information KYND has access to.
